Neighbours off the Co-op.

- Information regarding shares for sale will be provided after the two week stay and meeting 15 members. The names and contact details of members on neighbouring sites will be provided. It is your responsibility to contact and/or meet these members.
- Members are not permitted to take deposits for the sale of their share. Deposits are payable to the Co-op only after you have been approved as eligible for membership. Once approved as eligible for membership, to secure a site, you may lodge the share transfer fee of \$7,000 with the Treasurer, and it will be held in the Co-op bank account as a refundable deposit.
- Once your membership is approved and a member agrees to transfer a share to you, the Co-op can process the share transfer and formally ratify you as a member.
