Business arising from Previous Meeting

- 1. Confirmation of Minutes of February Meeting: prop. Ralph E, sec. Peter O'H; approved unanimously.
- 2. Location of NPWS key on Big Hill fire track gate: to be housed at Roger (Fire Chief) and Belinda's in an accessible location to be made known to resident members.
- 3. Fire Access Trails: A3 map prints for Camp Kitchen (CK) and jpeg files to Peter for website; discussion re closed fire trail at Bollard & Cox/Quinn's sites which is deemed unacceptable, no action agreed at present; use term "Fire Access Trail".
- 4. Removal of recently planted bamboo at Northgate deemed 'disgraceful and inexcusable'
- 5. Toilet at CK cleaned, repaired and now in good working order; railings replaced on staircase; many thanks to Men's Shed for this essential work! Expense on materials is ongoing maintenance (not CK reno budget), and further minor work on the facility approved in principle.
- 6. Fox & cat eradication: held over till April;

Secretary's Report

- 1. Letters from Dept Fair Trading (procedural) and KSC (final approval of Camp Kitchen extension);
- 2. Filing cabinet installed Ralph's office (\$120);
- 3. Building Insurance policy comprises 85 pages, so agreed to keep electronically;
- 4. Two security cameras installed in CK and Machinery Shed to be evaluated for April meeting re purchasing further units; Dan to investigate powering them by solar;
- 5. Overdue members: only one non-resident owing some \$20 -all others now paid-up current within one year.
- 6. Treasury billed Frank for George W's last four months' stay "by default", and the meeting decided unanimously that these charges be waived.

Road Report

- 1. Ralph to talk to Police and KSC re possible installation of "No Through Road" signs at Illa Langi & Nevertire Roads to curb increased non-Goolawah traffic on our internal roads.
- 2. Nevertire quite deteriorated: Ralph to get quote from GME and time-frame for road works, with option for pot-holing. Ralph estimates roughly \$10-15K.
- 3. Ralph to write to Council re deterioration of Maria River Rd (Lyn's accident).
- 4. Ralph to write to Crown Lands re Mark Dunn's infringement on the road reserve and Illa Langi's deterioration, pending Section 96 resolution and transfer to KSC.

Fire Report

- 1. Several areas to be burned once fire restrictions are lifted (next month?); Illa Langi piles to be burned also all useable timbers now removed.
