Business Arising: -

<u>Rules Update</u>: Roger reported on committee progress, with some rules taking inordinate amounts of time and others finalised quickly; final draft will comprehensive; Goolawah's updated rules to be similar to Bundagen's, which have been accepted by DFT.

Koala Habitat Trust: Mark Sheahan and colleague to visit the Co-op June 13th;

<u>Last Resort</u>: installing the straw & mud walls made for a very labour-intensive weekend; 20+ people in attendance both days.

<u>Pigs</u>: trap installed by Local Land Services has so far caught one kangaroo; Red Hill still under attack; Jason will introduce new hunting team in the near future;

Machinery:
