# Last Resort Report:

Trinh - requesting submissions from community members interested in designing & building the Fire Tractor Shelter to house expensive fire equipment from the elements on Red Hill. Fire Squad thinks a structure with roof, sides and back walls, open at the front and on gravel/crusher dust will be fine.

- To get an idea, quotes from local external shed companies are around \$7K for materials only, up to \$11K to build - not including council fees.
- Denis has provided a costing of materials only, for something similar to what his caravan is currently housed in, \$6650.
- Contact Dave L & Trinh for help to present designs and budget to community meeting.
- Northern Fence:

Dan - Greg was coming to meeting but had to go to hospital. His estimate \$5-\$7K to clear land and re-fence northern boundary. He has already fixed fence from machinery shed to first western boundary corner.

- Kev says we can take funds from Road Maintenance Budget to pay.
- If it goes over \$7K then we will bring it back to the community meeting for discussion.
