Reason/s for having the animal/s: We currently have 5 hens and 1 pet rabbit. We have the hens for eggs and eventually to assist in soil development in our future gardens.

Care and welfare: Our hens are in a dome which is regularly moved to fresh ground. They have access to sun and shade and protection from rain etc. Our rabbit lives outdoors in a cage with access to grass and greens from the garden.

Range and containment: They do not free range

Protection of the Environment including Native Flora & Fauna: Hens and rabbit do not free range and their food is contained within the dome so native animals cannot access it.

Waste and maintenance: Chook poo and rabbit poo remain on the ground, creating fertiliser.

Noise and other impacts on people: Hens make minimal noise

Removal of animals: Any hens that die naturally will be composted and diseased/sick hens will be killed humanly and composted.
