Subject: Request for Approval of Sheep Management Plan via Ordinary Resolution

Dear Goolawah members,

We are writing to formally request that our proposed ISMP be considered and approved for a six-month trial period, through an ordinary resolution, at the next general meeting.

Proposed Resolution:

That Aliya, Crow and family, is approved to keep two sheep on their 2.5 acre site within Goolawah, for the purposes of rotational grazing (lawn mowing) and garden fertilization as part of their permaculture inspired lifestyle, subject to compliance with the submitted management plan. This approval will be for a trial period of six months, after which the arrangement will be reviewed to assess its viability for permanent keeping, provided no unforeseen negative circumstances arise.

Key details:

- The attached ISMP outlines measures to ensure minimal community impact, including rotational grazing, secure shelter, supervised tethering, and regular manure management.

- The trial aims to evaluate the environmental and practical benefits of integrating sheep as a sustainable alternative to mechanical lawn mowing and to improve soil health all over our site.

Next step:

If approved, then we aim to acquire two young female sheep, which breed is suitable for our family and situation within the next 6-9 months.

We are more than happy to address any questions or concerns you may have and look forward to discussing the potential benefits this initiative can bring to our cooperative.

Please advise me if anything is missing in this proposal, to ensure it can go ahead for a vote at the next GM.
